Escape to Mackinac Island

August 11-14, 2015

One of our more popular tours! This charming island offers a slower pace of life. In addition to the included tours, guests can stroll along the boardwalk lined with a variety of shops, sample Mackinac's world famous fudge, ride a bike, explore its many art galleries, or simply watch the world go by from a comfy porch chair.

Day 1: (D) This morning we depart for Mackinaw City to board the ferry for the 16-minute transfer to **Mackinac Island**. Many people have remarked that a visit to this charming island is "like stepping back into time to a living Victorian village." Transportation is limited to horse and buggy, bicycle or by foot. Upon arrival we check into the *Island House Hotel*, our home for the next three nights. Dinner is included this evening in the hotel's *1852 Grill Room*.

Day 2: (B, L) After an included breakfast, we board our carriages for the **Mackinac Island Carriage Tour**. Sit back and relax while your driver relates the history of the island and its colorful inhabitants. A stop will be made at **Wings of Mackinac**, a charming butterfly conservatory filled with lush plants, colorful flowers which provide a home for their exotic collection of butterflies. Be sure to bring your camera.

After the tour we will partake in the **Grand Luncheon Buffet*** at **The Grand Hotel**. The buffet features hot and cold entrees, salad, sumptuous desserts and more. The hotel first opened its doors in 1887 as a summer retreat for vacationers from Chicago, Erie, Montreal and Detroit. Over the years, the staff has welcomed famous guests including five U.S. presidents, author/humorist Mark Twain and actors Jimmy Durante and Esther Williams. In 1980, the hotel was the location for the film *Somewhere in Time*, starring Christopher Reeve and Jane Seymour. Be sure to take a few minutes to view the movie memorabilia. The rest of the day is yours to relax or sightsee on your own. Dinner is on your own this evening. **Dress code for lunch at the Grand Hotel: Please, no tank tops, muscle shirts, spaghetti strap tops, or short shorts are permitted in the dining room.*

Day 3: (B, D) The day is free for you to explore the islands' quaint shops, boutiques, restaurants, art galleries and museums. For the more adventurous; bike around the island, play a round of golf, or go horseback riding. Of course, no visit to the island would be complete without a sampling of their famous fudge! Treat yourself and don't forget; it makes a great gift! Tonight join your tour director for a **farewell dinner** at the hotel.

Day 4: (B) After breakfast we board the ferry to return to the mainland and continue our journey home.
